This funding will support the installation of a needed sewer lift station for the Laurel Glen multi-family housing project in Laurel, Delaware, which will create 36 rental units for workforce households in one of Sussex County's most underserved areas. Laurel has a population of 3,865 people and is extremely rural. This sewer lift will help Laurel Glen address critical rural housing shortages in a market with a 1.1% vacancy rate and long waitlists, providing options for workers like EMTs, teachers, and service employees. The installation of the sewer lift station is essential infrastructure, improving public utility capacity in a rural area with limited wastewater resources and supporting long-term community growth and resilience.

This project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it delivers essential infrastructure to support workforce housing in a rural area with severe shortages, helping meet demand for EMTs, teachers, and service workers. By expanding utility capacity, it promotes long-term community growth, economic stability, and efficient use of public resources.

This project has a Federal nexus because it is for the purposes authorized in section 306 of the Consolidated Farm and Rural Development Act, 7 U.S. Code section 1926(a).
